# 1- PRIOR THE CONFERENCE

### a) Book your room

#### Important information:

Payments are to be made upon your arrival at the hotel, unless otherwise stated. A valid credit card must be given when making your online reservation in order to guarantee and secure your reservation.

All cancellation and modifications of reservation must be done in writing to the hotel, at the latest 72 hours prior to the confirmed arrival. If you do not cancel your reservation following this procedure, the hotel will be entitled to charge you for the entire stay booked. Cancellation and modifications are only considered as valid if approved in writing by the hotel.


Once you are registered, customize your SymfonyCon experience by completing your profile:

# c) Print your badge

For safety reasons we ask all participants to print their badge before arriving at the conference. There will be no printing on site.

# 2- JOINING THE CONFERENCE CENTER

## a) By train

Brussels is accessible from most of Europe by train! We recommand your to travel this way to limit your carbon footprint. Brussels has three train stations going from north to south they are **Brussel Noord**, **Brussel Zuid-Midi and Brussel Central**. Brussel Zuid-Midi handles the international services including Eurostar, Thalys and ICE along with a number of inter city routes. All three train stations are on the metro line.

- Brussel Noord: 24-minutes' walk to the Conference center or 7 minutes in public transports.
- Brussel Zuid-Midi: 20-minutes' walk to the Conference center or 7 minutes in public transports.
- Brussel Central: 3-minutes' walk to the Conference center.

### b) By plane

For our most geographically distanced participants, we propose attractive discounts, up to -15%, on a wide range of public fares on all AIR FRANCE and KLM flights worldwide. If you wish to arrive before the conference or extend your stay, the discounts may also apply as the travel validity period runs from November 28, 2023 to December 15, 2023. Once landed in Brussels airport, you can reach the SymfonyCon Brussels 2023:

#### · With a taxi

To ensure a safe journey at a guaranteed price, we recommend that you always take an official taxi outside arrival hall. Do not use unlicensed taxis. You can recognize an official taxi by the T- license plate and the blue-yellow symbol at the front of the taxi (see the logo on the right). There is a clearly organised queue just in front of the arrival hall. Take your time to step into one, in all trust. If you are approached outside the baggage claim area by persons claiming to be taxi, we invite you to decline any offer of transportation. It costs around 50€ to Brussels city center.

#### · With a shuttle

You will find the train station directly under the Departure and Arrival Halls of the airport (level -1). The escalator or lift will take you directly to the platform. Brussels Airport is a speedy 17 minutes by train from the **Central Station**, stopping at the European Institutions on the way. At peak times, 6 trains run every hour and from the Central Station, which is only three minutes walk to SQUARE. The ticket is 10,3€ / adult. Children under 12 can travel free with an adult.





## c) By car

There are two public car parks with over 1700 parking spaces. Parking Albertine is the closest car park and is situated underneath SQUARE with direct access to the venue from the inside. Both car parks are accessible 24H and both have recharging facilities for electric cars. For direct access from the car park, please go to level -3 and follow the directions to SQUARE. This route provides direct elevator access.

A short walk away is the Grand Place car park which is conveniently placed midway between SQUARE and the Grand Place

### d) By public transportations

The Central Station of Brussels is a short walk across the Mont-des-Arts public gardens. All main tram, bus, metro and train lines converge here, as well as the fast train from Brussels International Airport. Train routes to every part of Belgium run from the same station which includes the cities of Antwerp, Brugge, Charleroi, Gent, Mons and Liège.

- Metro lines 1 and 5, tram lines 38, 63, 65, 86
- Bus lines 29, 48, 66, 71, 86, N06, N08, N09, N10, N11
- · Bus lines 48 and 95
- Bus lines 38, 71, N06, N08, N09, N10, N11, N12
- Trams 92 and 93

Tickets from 2,50 € per journey (price depending on the distance).

# b) Food and beverages included

All tickets (workshop, conference, workshop+conference) include a morning coffee break, lunch and afternoon coffee break per day. Dinners are not provided. In addition, a welcome coffee break will be served on **December 7** from 7:30 so **feel free to join us early to avoid the queue.** 

Lunches will be served in lunch boxes. You can pick them up in the lobby and in the exhibition area. Only those who have registered and have a badge will be able to pick up their lunch box.

# c) Water accessibility

# 6- DISABILITY INFORMATION

### a) Slow walkers & wheelchairs

- All spaces are wheelchair accessible. There are four entrances providing easy access for disabled:
  - 3, Coudenberg
  - SQUARE terrace
  - o 2, Rue Ravenstein
  - 2, Rue des Sols access via parking -3
- · Dedicated seating will be organized at front and side rows.
- · 10-minute breaks are provided between each talk for moving time.

### b) Visually impaired & color blindness

- Dedicated seating will be organized at front rows.
- · Sign language interpreter during talks can be organized upon request by email (events@symfony.com)

### c) Guide and assistance dogs

Guide and assistance dogs are welcome. They must have current travel documents (vaccination, document stating that the animal is a service animal), to be presented upon arrival. Participants must maintain control of their animal at all times and keep them on a leash or harness within the venue.

# 7- COMING WITH CHILDREN

## a) Childcare

Babysitting is available upon advance request only (minimum of 7 days). The request must be send by email (event@symfony.com) and be specific with the number of children, their age, requested day and duration.

# b) Breastfeeding

Breastfeeding is permitted wherever breatfeeding visitors feel comfortable in the Conference center. There is no dedicated room available in the venue.

# 8- FURTHER INFORMATION

## a) First aid station

Security agents, assigned on every level, are all trained to take care of participants in need and do first aid.

If you begin to feel ill or need medical assistance, please do not hesitate to ask someone from the organization or security agents.

In case of an emergency, Square center is located next to a large hospital.

## b) Non-gendered toilets

At Square most of toilets are gendered. For your comfort, a non-gender sign will be added on the toilets dedicated to reduced mobility persons.

## c) Prayer room

There is no prayer room inside the conference area.
