2- JOINING THE CONFERENCE VENUE

<u>a) By train</u>

As Europe's largest interchange station, the modern <u>Berlin Hauptbahnhof</u> connects rails from every direction and is located in the centre of Berlin, near the Parliament and houses of government.

Yet Berlin has many other large long-distance train stations, such as the Südkreuz, the Ostkreuz and Ostbahnhof, Gesundbrunnen (Nordkreuz and Spandau in the west. Each station offers quick public transit into the city centre.

- Berlin Hauptbahnhof -> AlexanderPlatz: 6 minutes / Südkreuz -> AlexanderPlatz: 20 minutes ;
- Ostkreuz -> AlexanderPlatz: 9 minutes / Gesundbrunnen -> AlexanderPlatz: 8 minutes ;
- Spandau -> AlexanderPlatz: 40 minutes

<u>b) By plane</u>

For our most geographically distanced participants, the <u>Berlin Brandenburg Airport (BER)</u>. "Willy Brandt" has been opened and has replaced the airports Tegel and Schönefeld as central airport. In addition, BER has its own railway station directly below the terminal. Once landed in BER airport, you can reach SymfonyLive Berlin 2023:

• With public transportation

You can change from the airplane directly and comfortably to the rail. You will find the train station directly under the Departure and Arrival Halls of the Terminal 1 (level U1 and U2).

Journey times from BER Terminals to Alexanderplatz is around **25 minutes.** More information on the lines and ticket prices are available on <u>www.s-bahn-</u> berlin.de

With a taxi

To ensure a safe journey, we recommend that you always take an official taxi outside arrival hall. Real taxis can be identified by the Berlin license plate and the license number on the back window of the vehicle. There is no license number in Berlin that is higher than 8000.

It costs around 70-75€ to Berlin city center.

Here you will find taxi numbers and further information about taxis in Berlin.

c) By car

There are few public car parks around AlexanderPlatz:

- Rathaus passagen is the closest car park, only 100m from the Cinema.
- **APCOA** (Underground car park Alexa) is situated at 500m from the Cinema and proposes Electric Car Charging Spaces and a daily ticket at 20€.

3- JOINING SYMFONYLIVE

<u>a) Workshops</u>

The workshops will take place on June, 18-19 at **The Social Hub Hotel**. Address: **Alexanderstraße 40, 10179 Berlin** Access:

- 10-minute walk to Alexanderplatz Station and a 3-minute walk to Jannowitzbrücke station.
- From Berlin Central Station, take the S3, S5, S7, or S9, on the S-Bahn local railway for 8 minutes, and take the exit S+U Jannowitzbrücke. Then it is only a 3-minute walk away.
- The hotel has its own private parking lot for 4€/hour or 17€/day (no reservations possible).

Present yourself at the welcome desk with your pre-printed badge. We will be at your disposal for any further information.

Don't forget to check the recommendations received by email to participate in the workshops. This will make it easier to get started with the workshops.

The conference will take place on October 5 & 6 at **Cinestar Cubix Alexanderplatz.** Address: **Rathausstrasse 1, 10178 Berlin**

4- CATERING

a) Indicate your food preference

Once you have registered, log in to your conference profile, click on Conferences and then on Update your Preferences. Here you go, you can choose Your food preference as "No special meal" or "I'm vegetarian".

If you don't specify your diet beforehand, you will not be able to choose a vegetarian lunch on site.

b) Food and beverages included

All tickets (workshop, conference, workshop+conference) include a morning coffee break, lunch and afternoon coffee break per day. Dinners are not provided. In addition, welcome coffee breaks will be served on June 20 starting at 8:00 a.m., so feel free to join us early to avoid the waiting line!

Lunches will be served as sandwich lunch boxes. You can pick them up in the exhibition area. Only registrants wearing a badge will be able to pick up a lunch box.

5- DISABILITY INFORMATION

a) Slow walkers & wheelchairs

- All spaces are wheelchair accessible.
- · Dedicated seating will be organized.
- 10-minute breaks are provided between each talk for moving time.

b) Visually impaired & color blindness

- Dedicated seating will be organized at front rows.
- Sign language interpreter during talks can be organized upon request by email (events@symfony.com)

c) Guide and assistance dogs

Guide and assistance dogs are welcome. They must have current travel documents (vaccination, document stating that the animal is a service animal), to be presented upon arrival. Participants must maintain control of their animal at all times and keep them on a leash or harness within the venue.

6- COMING WITH CHILDREN

a) Childcare

Babysitting is available upon advance request only (minimum of 7 days). The request must be send by email (event@symfony.com) and be specific with the number of children, their age, requested day and duration.

b) Breastfeeding

Breastfeeding is permitted wherever breatfeeding visitors feel comfortable in the workshops hotel and Cinema. There is no dedicated room available.

7- FURTHER INFORMATION

a) First aid station

If you begin to feel ill or need medical assistance, please do not hesitate to ask someone from the organization. In case of an emergency, Cinestar Cubix is located close to large hospitals.

b) Gender neutral toilets

At the workshops hotel, toilets are gendered neutral.

At Cinestar Cubix toilets are all gendered. For your comfort, we recommend using the toilets in your hotel room whenever possible.

c) Prayer room

There is no prayer room inside the conference and workshops venues.
