

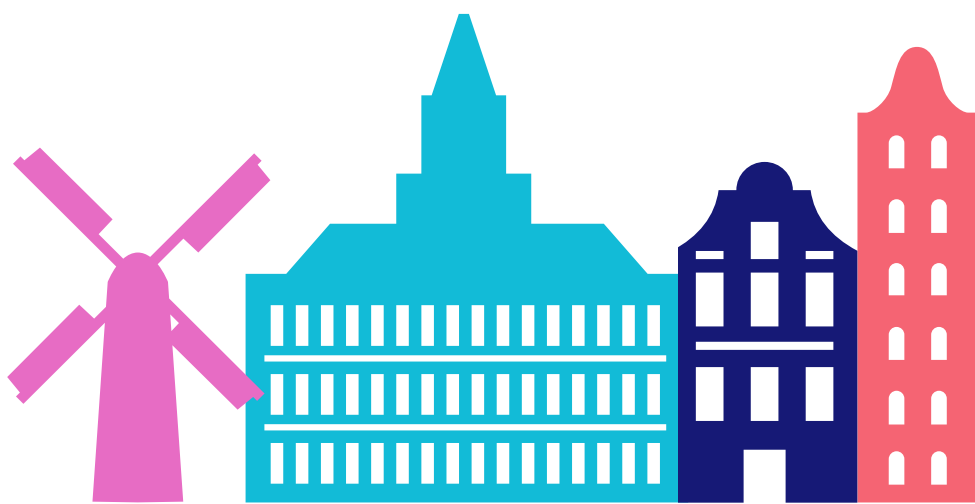

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1- PRIOR TO THE EVENT

a) Book your accommodation

Some rooms have been pre-booked at negotiated rates in Amsterdam (subject to availability). Booking links are available with special terms:

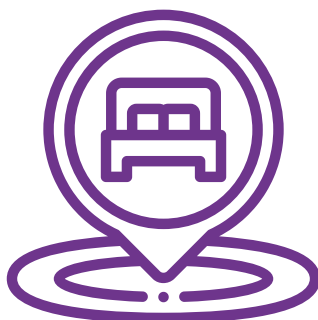

For safety reasons we ask all participants to print their badge before arriving at the conference. **There will be no printing on site.**

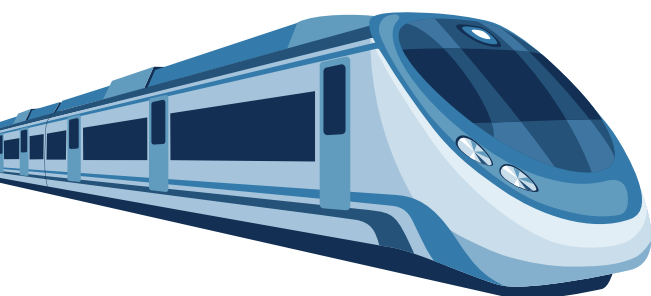
Lanyards and badge pocket will be available at the welcome desk.

2- GETTING TO AMSTERDAM

a) By train

Amsterdam is well-connected by train from major European cities such as Paris, Brussels, Berlin, Frankfurt, and London... Upon arrival at **Amsterdam Centraal Station**, the **Beurs van Berlage** is just a **5-minute walk (approximately 300 meters)** away. **Exit the station towards Damrak**, and you'll find the venue on your left as you walk towards Dam Square.

b) By plane

If you're traveling from afar, we're happy to offer discounted airfares with both Air France-KLM and the Lufthansa Group airlines to help make your journey to SymphonyCon Amsterdam 2025 a little easier!

3 steps to claim your 10% discount:

Lufthansa Group airline network

c) By Car

Driving in Amsterdam's city center can be challenging due to traffic and limited parking. However, if you choose to drive:

- **Nearest parking garages:**
 - Parking Centrum Oosterdok: Approximately a 15-minute walk from the venue. It's more accessible, cost-effective, and offers 136 electric charging points.
 - Q-Park Bijenkorf and Q-Park Amsterdam Central Station: Both are within walking distance and provide facilities for visitors with disabilities.

We recommend booking parking in advance where possible.

d) By Public Transportation

Amsterdam offers a well-connected and reliable public transport system operated by [GVB](#).

- **Tram:** Several tram lines stop near Beurs van Berlage. The closest stop is Dam/De Bijenkorf, served by trams 4 and 14.
- **Metro:** The nearest metro stations are Nieuwmarkt and Centraal Station, both within walking distance.
- **Bus:** Multiple bus lines serve the area around Amsterdam Centraal Station, which is a short walk from the venue.

Tickets can be purchased at stations, via GVB ticket machines, or through the GVB app. For unlimited public transport during your stay, consider purchasing a GVB multi-day ticket (1 to 7 days).



e) Taxis and Accessibility Transport

- **Taxis:** Official taxi stands are available throughout Amsterdam, including near Beurs van Berlage. You can also book taxis via the Taxi Central Amsterdam at +31 (0)20-777 7777.
- **Ride apps:** Services like Uber and Bolt operate in Amsterdam.

Accessible transport:

- **Staxi** provides wheelchair-accessible taxis.
- **Connexion** offers regional accessible transportation.

The Beurs van Berlage is accessible to everyone, with facilities to accommodate visitors with disabilities.

3- GETTING TO SYMFONYCON

a) Workshops

The pre-conference workshops will take place from November 25 to 26 at **Meet Berlage**, just few meters down the street from Beurs van Berlage.

b) Food and beverages included

All tickets (workshop, conference, workshop+conference) include a morning coffee break, lunch and afternoon coffee break per day. Dinners are not provided.

In addition, a welcome coffee will be served on November 27 and 28 **from 8:00** so feel free to join us early to avoid the queue!

Lunch buffets will be available in the exhibition area.

c) Water accessibility

7- DISABILITY INFORMATION



a) Slow walkers & wheelchairs

Thanks to the integrated lift, visitors can also enter the Beurs via the main entrance stairs. All main halls of the Beurs van Berlage are located on the ground floor and feature wide, step-free entrances, making them fully wheelchair accessible.

Other breakout rooms are situated on the first floor or in the basement, both of which are easily reachable via a glass lift.

Dedicated seating will be organized at front and side rows.

10-minute breaks are provided between each talk for moving time.



b) Visual impairments

The venue is fully equipped to accommodate visitors with visual impairments. Features include clear markings on staircases to indicate the end of each flight and lift buttons designed with visually impaired visitors in mind.

c) Deaf & hard-of-hearing

Dedicated seating will be organized at front rows.

Sign language interpreter or technical devices during talks can be organized upon request in advance by email (events@symfony.com).

d) Guide and assistance dogs

Service dogs are warmly welcome at the venue. For everyone's comfort and safety, we kindly ask that they wear a mouth guard while inside the building. Please make sure to bring the necessary travel documents that confirm your dog is a certified service animal. We also ask that service dogs remain on a leash or harness and under your supervision at all times during the event.



8- COMING WITH CHILDREN

a) Childcare

Babysitting is available upon advance request only (minimum of 7 days). The request must be send by email (event@symfony.com) and be specific with the number of children, their age, requested day and duration.

b) Breastfeeding

Breastfeeding is welcome throughout the conference center, wherever nursing parents feel most comfortable. While there isn't a dedicated nursing room on site, a fridge will be available if needed. If you'd like assistance or access, please don't hesitate to contact the reception team in advance or on arrival.

If you begin to feel ill or need medical assistance, please do not hesitate to ask someone from the organization or security agents.

b) Non-gendered toilets

At Square most of toilets are gendered. For your comfort, a non-gender sign will be added on several toilets
