Badge, transportation, venue, accommodation, catering...
Everything you need to know!

1- PRIOR TO THE EVENT

a) Complete your account information

Once you are registered, customize your SymphonyLive experience by completing your profile:

- Personalize your badge
- Select your workshops (if applicable)
- Select your talks
- Choose your t-shirt size and food preferences


b) Print your badge

For safety reasons we ask all participants to print their badge before arriving at the conference. There will be no printing on site.

Lanyards and badge pocket will be available at the welcome desk.

2- JOINING THE CONFERENCE VENUE

a) By train

As Europe's largest interchange station, the modern Berlin Hauptbahnhof connects rails from every direction and is located in the centre of Berlin, near the Parliament and houses of government.

Yet Berlin has many other large long-distance train stations, such as the Südkreuz, the Ostkreuz and Ostbahnhof, Gesundbrunnen (Nordkreuz and Spandau in the west. Each station offers quick public transit into the city centre.

- Berlin Hauptbahnhof -> AlexanderPlatz: 6 minutes / Südkreuz -> AlexanderPlatz: 20 minutes ;
- Ostkreuz -> AlexanderPlatz: 9 minutes / Gesundbrunnen -> AlexanderPlatz: 8 minutes ;
- Spandau -> AlexanderPlatz: 40 minutes

b) By plane

For our most geographically distanced participants, the Berlin Brandenburg Airport (BER) "Willy Brandt" has been opened and has replaced the airports Tegel and Schönefeld as central airport. In addition, BER has its own railway station directly below the terminal. Once landed in BER airport, you can reach SymphonyLive Berlin:



c) With public transportation

You can transfer directly from the airport to the rail network. The train station Flughafen BER – Terminal 1-2 is located beneath Terminal 1 (levels U1 and U2). Regional trains and S-Bahn lines connect BER to Alexanderplatz in approximately 30–45 minutes (fastest trains around 25–30 minutes).

A single ticket (zones ABC) costs €5.00. A 24-hour ticket (ABC) costs €12.90 and allows unlimited travel within Berlin.

d) With a taxi

For a safe journey, take an official taxi from the ranks outside the arrivals hall at Berlin Brandenburg Airport.

Official taxis are beige with a roof sign and visible license number. Fare to Berlin city centre is around €60–75.

e) By car

Public parking near Alexanderplatz includes:

- Rathauspassagen – central car park within walking distance of the cinema (600 spaces).
- APCOA Underground car park Alexa – large underground garage ~100 m from Alexanderplatz with electric charging points. Daily maximum is around €25



3- JOINING SYMFONYLIVE

a) Workshops

Here is the timetable for both days (timezone CEST):

- 09:30: Welcome coffee and setup
- 09:45: Start of workshops
- 12:30 - 01:30: Lunch break
- 05:30: End of workshops

Depending on how the workshop is going, the trainer might adapt and change this schedule. The workshop lasts 7 hours a day excluding the lunch time.

It's important that you have a well-configured computer, as we can't guarantee that the trainers will be able to help everyone set up their device.

- Welcome, morning & afternoon coffee breaks and lunch will be provided each day.
- Wifi is also provided throughout the workshop.

Your workshop session will take place at Mindspace Münzstraße, situated in Münzstraße 12, 10178, Berlin.

Public transportation (From near to far):

- Line U8 - stop "Weinmeisterstr"
- Lines M2 / M4 - stop "S+U Alexanderpl/Memhardstr"
- Line U2 - stop "Rosa-Luxemburg-Platz"

4- CATERING

a) Indicate your food preference

Once you have registered, log in to your conference profile, click on Conferences and then on Update your Preferences. Here you go, you can choose Your food preference as "No special meal" or "I'm vegetarian".

If you don't specify your diet beforehand, you will not be able to choose a vegetarian lunch on site.

b) Food and beverages included

All tickets (workshop, conference, workshop+conference) include a morning coffee break, lunch and afternoon coffee break per day. Dinners are not provided. In addition, welcome coffee breaks will be served starting at 8:00 a.m., so feel free to join us early to avoid the waiting line!

Lunches will be served as sandwich lunch boxes. You can pick them up in the exhibition area. Only registrants wearing a badge will be able to pick up a lunch box.

5- DISABILITY INFORMATION

a) Slow walkers & wheelchairs

- All spaces are wheelchair accessible.
- Dedicated seating will be organized.
- 10-minute breaks are provided between each talk for moving time.

b) Visually impaired & color blindness

- Dedicated seating will be organized at front rows.
- Sign language interpreter during talks can be organized upon request by email (events@symfony.com)

c) Guide and assistance dogs

Guide and assistance dogs are welcome. They must have current travel documents (vaccination, document stating that the animal is a service animal), to be presented upon arrival. Participants must maintain control of their animal at all times and keep them on a leash or harness within the venue.


6- COMING WITH CHILDREN

a) Childcare

Babysitting is available upon advance request only (minimum of 7 days). The request must be sent by email (event@symfony.com) and be specific with the number of children, their age, requested day and duration.

b) Breastfeeding

Breastfeeding is permitted wherever breastfeeding visitors feel comfortable in the workshop area and Cinema. There is no dedicated room available.



7- FURTHER INFORMATION

a) First aid station

If you begin to feel ill or need medical assistance, please do not hesitate to ask someone from the organization.

In case of an emergency, Cinestar Cubix is located close to large hospitals.

b) Gender neutral toilets

At the workshops hotel, toilets are gendered neutral.

At Cinestar Cubix toilets are all gendered. For your comfort, we recommend using the toilets in your hotel room whenever possible.

c) Prayer room

There is no prayer room inside the conference and workshops venues.
