c) Print your badge

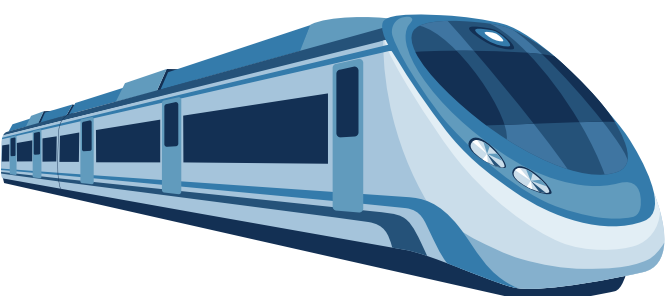
For safety reasons we ask all participants to print their badge before arriving at the conference. Lanyards and badge pocket will be available at the welcome desk.

2- GETTING TO WARSAW

a) By train

Warsaw is well-connected by train from major European cities such as Berlin, Vienna, Prague, Budapest, and Bratislava. Upon arrival at Warszawa Centralna Station, the Hilton Warsaw City is a short 5-minute tram ride (or a 20-minute walk) away. You can easily take tram line 10 directly from Dworzec Centralny to Rondo Daszyńskiego, from where the venue is just a short walk.

b) By plane

c) By Car

Driving in Warsaw's city center can be busy during peak hours, but reaching the venue by car is straightforward. If you choose to drive:

- **On-site Parking:** The Hilton Warsaw City offers convenient parking directly at the hotel. Rates are 180 PLN per day (Monday to Thursday) and 150 PLN per day (Friday to Sunday).
- **Nearby Alternatives:** Additional public parking spaces and nearby underground garages (such as Parking Towarowa) are also available within short walking distance, including accessible options and EV charging stations.

We recommend checking availability or booking your parking space in advance where possible.

d) By Public Transportation

Warsaw offers a well-connected and reliable public transport system operated by [WTP](#) (Warszawski transport Publiczny).

- **Tram:** Several tram lines stop near the venue. The closest stops are Muzeum Powstania Warszawskiego and Rondo Daszyńskiego, served by trams 1, 9, 10, 22, and 24.
- **Metro:** The nearest metro station is Rondo Daszyńskiego (Line M2), which is just a 5-minute walk from the hotel.
- **Bus:** Multiple bus lines serve the area, including lines 106, 109, and 178, stopping nearby at Rondo Daszyńskiego or Muzeum Powstania Warszawskiego.

Tickets can be purchased at station ticket machines, directly on buses and trams, or through local mobility apps like [Jakdojade](#), [Mobilet](#), [Gopay](#)... For unlimited public transport during your stay, consider purchasing a WTP 24-hour or 72-hour pass.

e) Taxis and Accessibility Transport

- **Taxis:** Official taxi stands are available throughout Warsaw, including at Warszawa Centralna Station and major hotels. You can also book registered taxis via major local operators like [Ele Taxi](#) at +48 22 811 11 11.
- **Ride apps:** Services like Uber, Bolt, and Free Now operate extensively in Warsaw.
- **Accessible transport:** Taxis with wheelchair accessibility can be requested through major taxi fleets or apps (such as Bolt Accessibility). Public transport in Warsaw is also highly accessible, with low-floor buses and trams across the city.

7- DISABILITY INFORMATION

a) Slow walkers & wheelchairs

Thanks to step-free access and automatic doors at the main entrance, all visitors can easily enter the venue. The main conference halls at the Hilton Warsaw City are located on the first floor fully wheelchair accessible via central elevators.

Dedicated seating will be reserved at the front and side rows for attendees who need easier access.

10-minute breaks are provided between each talk to allow ample moving time.

b) Deaf & hard-of-hearing

Dedicated seating will be organized at front rows.

c) Guide and assistance dogs

Service dogs are warmly welcome at the venue. For everyone's comfort and safety, we kindly ask that they wear a mouth guard while inside the building. Please make sure to bring the necessary travel documents that confirm your dog is a certified service animal. We also ask that service dogs remain on a leash or harness and under your supervision at all times during the event.
